

Photography Guidelines | Cats

BACKGROUND

Stick to a background that **isn't busy**. **The focus is the cat!** Adding a colorful blanket behind them and putting them on a chair can attract attention! Open windows for light!

POSES

GOAL: Make the cat look cute and show multiple angles.

IMPORTANT: One photo **MUST** have the cat facing directly at the camera at **eye level**. Do **NOT** zoom in too much -- there must be space on the side of their face! This is the **most important** shot.

One photo should be a full body shot - sitting or standing is best

*Maximize the number of photos you take!
Aim for 3-4 usable ones.*

DEVICES

We recommend finding volunteers with high-quality phone cameras - iPhone 11 XR and newer iPhones have very good cameras. **Use portrait mode!**

*** all attached photos are taken w/ an iPhone XR**

EDITING

- Brighten the photos
 - Edit so that the color is slightly enhanced, but not too much
